AN ACT to transfer the functions, powers and duties of the South Jersey Port Corporation from the Department of Environmental Protection to the Department of Labor and Industry.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. The South Jersey Port Corporation, a body corporate and
2 politic, established pursuant to P. L. 1968, c. 60 (C. 12:11A-1
3 et seq.), together with all of its functions, powers and duties, is
4 hereby transferred from the Department of Environmental Pro-
5 tection to the Department of Labor and Industry.

1 2. This act shall not affect the terms of office of the present
2 members of the South Jersey Port Corporation or any rights or
3 protection afforded persons under any employment contracts or
4 under any pension or retirement plan.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill would place the South Jersey Port Corporation within the Department of Labor and Industry.

This bill transfers the South Jersey Port Corporation, which was created in 1968, from the Department of Environmental Protection to the Department of Labor and Industry. Both departments support this transfer because of the close relationship between the functions and responsibilities of the corporation and the Department of Labor and Industry.
