

Creating Website Links on the iPad

To create website links on the iPad home screen follow the directions below:

- 1. Within the iTunes download an install the "Duck Duck Go Browser"
- 2. Navigate to the URL of the website within the "Safari" app. Ex: "Google.com"
- **3.** Click on the share icon on the top of the browser. (The icon will appear as a square with an arrow pointing upwards.)
- 4. Select "Add to Home Screen".
- **5.** Open iPad settings by tapping on the gear icon.
- 6. On the left-hand side scroll down until "Safari" is in view.
- 7. Tap "Safari" to open the setting
- **8.** On the right-side tap "Default Browser App"
- 9. Tap "DuckDuckGo" to add a check beside it.
- **10.** Tap on "Safari" to navigate back to the previous page. The page should now show "DuckDuckGo" as the default browser.
- 11. Open the "DuckDuckGo" application by taping on the orange icon.
- 12. Tap on the "..." or the gear icon at the top right of the screen.
- 13. Tap the gear icon "Settings" to open settings
- 14. Tap "Data Clearing"
- **15.** Tap "Automatically Clear Data"
- 16. Slide the button beside "Automatically Clear Data" to enable the setting
- 17. Below "Action" tap "Clear Tabs and Data"
- **18.** Below Desired timing "App Exit Only" (This setting will clear data when the browser is closed)
- 19. Once the settings are changed the app can be closed.

We highly recommend using the DuckDuckGo Browser instead of the default Safari browser. DuckDuckGo can automatically clear data that is inputted during their session.
