

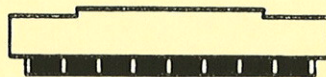

INTRODUCTION

The New Jersey State Library annually compiles statewide library statistics to help libraries analyze and improve programs and services. Trustees and library directors use the statistics to develop and justify budgets and for comparative evaluation of programs, staffing practices and collection development. School and college library staffs use the statistics to identify interlibrary loan resources and to establish cooperative service programs.

Public library services in New Jersey are provided primarily by three types of libraries:

- 1) **Municipal** - library established by law following a referendum in which the majority of voters decided to establish such a library. It is supported by taxes and is governed by a seven-member board, appointed by the mayor, which must include the mayor and the superintendent of schools. There are 220 municipal libraries identified in the tables by an **M**.
- 2) **County** - library established by law following a county-wide referendum approved by a majority of voters. It is supported by taxes and governed by a board known as the county library commission, composed of five members appointed by the freeholders. There are 14 county libraries identified in the tables by a **C**.
- 3) **Association** - library established, governed and supported by an association of citizens. Such an association is incorporated, forms its own constitution, appoints or elects its own board and is responsible for operation of the library. It may receive tax support from the local governing body. Only those association libraries whose services are free to the public are included in this publication. Some libraries formerly listed as association libraries are now branches or stations of their county libraries. Association libraries, numbering 71, are identified in the tables by an **A**.

In addition, there are six **joint** libraries in New Jersey which are identified in the tables by a **J**. A **joint** library is established by law following a referendum in two or more municipalities which was approved by the majority of voters. It is governed by a board appointed by the mayors of the participating municipalities.

The State Library has designated 26 libraries as **area** libraries. Each of these libraries is a headquarters library under contract with the state for specialized services to libraries within a given geographic area. The 26 area libraries are indicated in the tables by an asterisk (*) before the library name.

Summary tables show the number and percentage of population served by public libraries (Tables 1 and 2), libraries according to size of population served (Table 3), libraries according to total expenditures (Table 4) and libraries according to type and total expenditures (Table 5).

Tables showing individual library statistics by county and a state summary constitute the body of this publication. These data include the 1983 New Jersey state population estimate figures for population served and equalized valuation. Where a public library is supported by more than one municipality, the figures shown represent combined municipalities.

Explanation of the column headings follow. Where data has been taken from annual public library statistical reports for 1983, the line number of the report used is given in parentheses at the end of the explanation of each column heading below.

Column Heading	Explanation
POPULATION SERVED 1983	<p>Total population of New Jersey as of July 1, 1983, was 7,467,632, as stated in the Population Estimates for New Jersey, July 1, 1983, Provisional, issued by the Office of Demographic and Economic Analysis, New Jersey Department of Labor (September 1984). An estimated 7,380,824 of this population were served by a public library, defined as the accessibility of a public library within a municipal boundary or service provided by a county library. As indicated in the tables, two municipalities contract for library service. Their populations total 13,178. The remainder of the population, 66,809, is unserved, residing in municipalities not served by a county library or any local library.</p> <p>The population served by a county library is the total of all municipalities which provide tax support, including the populations of the member-libraries listed below the county-library entry.</p>
EQUALIZED VALUATION	<p>Equalized valuation of municipalities is supplied by the Division of Taxation, New Jersey Department of the Treasury, 1983 (Conformed Copy). Amounts are shown to the nearest thousand dollars and exclude municipalities which do not officially support library services. For county libraries, the equalized valuation reported is the total of all municipalities which provide tax support.</p>
INCOME: LOCAL TAX	<p>Local tax support is shown as reported by individual libraries as the sum of appropriated and additional tax support. (Line 14)</p>
INCOME: PER CAPITA STATE AID	<p>NOTE: Calculation of State Library Per Capita Aid is based on amounts expended from municipal or county budgets for library purposes.</p> <p>Amounts shown as per capita state aid were reported as paid in 1983 to municipalities and counties with libraries. State Aid to area libraries, research libraries and emergency aid/incentive grants is not shown in this column. (Line 16)</p>
INCOME: TOTAL	<p>NOTE: Two factors distort the comparison of data in this column with that of prior years. First, payment of state library aid due in October 1983 (FY 1984) was split into two payments, with the final payment not received until 1984. Second, supplemental checks for FY 1983 were issued late in 1983, but many libraries did not receive them until 1984. (Thus, this column in 1984 will include both 1983 late payments and those for 1984.)</p> <p>Amounts shown are library operating income from all sources (Line 24), but excluding the balance brought forward from the prior year (Line 11). State aid to area libraries, research libraries and for emergency aid/incentive grants is included. (Line 24 - Line 11)</p>

Column Heading	Explanation
EXPENDITURES: SALARIES, WAGES AND BENEFITS	Amounts reported here include salaries, wages and fringe benefits paid in 1983 to all library employees, including maintenance personnel, whether paid from the library budget or from the municipal or county budget. Retirement benefits paid are excluded. (Line 28)
EXPENDITURES: LIBRARY MATERIALS	Included are the amounts expended for books, periodicals, newspapers, microforms, all other non-print materials and binding. (Line 33)
EXPENDITURES: TOTAL	Total expenditures for 1983, as reported by libraries, represent current operations and exclude amounts spent for capital improvements, repayment of loans, etc. The difference of total expenditures, less those for salaries, wages and benefits and for library materials, represents all other operating expenditures. (Line 37)
NOTE: Total Expenditures may exceed Total Income, since the balance carried forward from 1982 (Line 11) has been deducted to yield current-year income.	
PER CAPITA: LOCAL EXPENDITURES	These amounts are derived by dividing total expenditures by population served. This column excludes amounts paid by municipalities in support of county libraries.
PER CAPITA: EXPENDITURES INCLUDING COUNTY TAX	For county libraries and county-library members, these amounts are derived from the sum of total local expenditures and county-library tax support paid, divided by population served. (While amounts paid by municipalities in support of a county library are not printed in these tables, they are included in these computations and were taken from county abstracts of ratables.)
NOTE: For Morris County libraries, both Level I and Level II taxes paid are used in this column.	
STAFF: PROFESSIONAL CERTIFIED	Numbers appearing in this column represent full-time and part-time librarians who hold New Jersey Professional Librarian Certifications. (Line 42a)
STAFF: FULL TIME	In this column, the number of individuals working full-time for a minimum of 30 hours per week as of December 1983 is reported. (Line 39b)
STAFF: FULL-TIME EQUIVALENTS (FTE)	This column represents the total of part-time and full-time employees equated to a number of full-time positions. The minimum work week is assumed to be 30 hours. (Line 42b)
VOLUMES OWNED YEAR END	These amounts represent the number of books (including books in microform if cataloged) reported as owned at the end of 1983. Other materials which are prepared, cataloged and recorded in the same manner as books are also reported here. (Line 47b)

Column Heading	Explanation
VOLUMES: PER CAPITA	These amounts are derived by dividing the number of volumes owned at the end of the year by the population served.
VOLUMES: PURCHASED DURING YEAR	This column reports the number of volumes purchased (including books in microform if cataloged) by public libraries in 1983, exclusive of gifts and volumes supplied by county libraries. (Line 45b)
TOTAL CIRCULATION	Reported here is the total circulation of library materials, adult and juvenile, including reciprocal borrowing, loans of library materials in bulk to other institutions and interlibrary loans. (Line 58)
SUBSCRIBED PERIODICALS	Numbers shown equal reported number of current paid subscription titles, including newspapers and magazines other than annuals, at the end of 1983. (Line 48)
HOURS OPEN WEEKLY	This column reports the number of hours per week the main library was open for public service during the major part of 1983. (Line 60)

AVERAGES

Averages have been calculated for county-member subtotals, county summaries, and state totals for the following columns: Per Capita Local Expenditures, Per Capita Expenditures Including County Tax, Volumes Per Capita, and Hours Open Weekly.

AVERAGE PRICE PAID FOR BOOKS IN 1983 BY NEW JERSEY PUBLIC LIBRARIES

Average Price Paid Per Volume in 1983: \$9.91

Many libraries use the average price per volume to assist in setting their budgets for library materials and to meet the State Library Aid Administrative-Code criteria for number of volumes purchased. As detailed in the New Jersey Administrative Code, 6:68-1.5(b), the funds spent for audiovisual materials, when divided by the average price paid per volume in the most-recent year published, gives an equivalent number of volumes which may be added to the number of print volumes purchased. Alternately, the total materials expenditure (except periodicals) may be divided by the average price per volume to yield the total number of volumes purchased.

From the 1983 annual statistical reports, Line 29 (Columns a+b), "Expenditures for Books," totaled \$10,781,421 for the 302 public libraries reporting. The total of Line 45, "Book Stock: Number of Volumes Purchased," was 1,088,300. Thus, the average price per volume purchased in 1983 was \$9.91.

The \$9.91 average price for 1983 will be used in 1985 for calculation of the FY 1986 State Library Aid requirement for the number of volumes purchased in 1984.
